RECOMMENDATIONS



COMMUNICATION

- More communication on jet ski speed limits
- Awareness raising among international tourists
- Trust-building and collaboration with jet ski providers and hotel managers



VISIBILITY

Increased visibility of the MPA and the speed limits by:

- Installing **signs** at Katič island
- Distributing (English)
 educational material for tourists



ENFORCEMENT

- Consistent enforcement of speed limit
- Address difficulties in compliance monitoring with speed limits
- Link compliance and economic benefits



DIVERSIFICATION OF TOURIST OFFERS

Encourage a conservation focus in tourism, by

- **Promoting eco-tours** and low impact activities
- Training tourism
 operators to integrate
 conservation in their
 tours



- Low awareness of the existence of Katič MPA
- Strong support for marine protection
- High safety risk perception of jet skis
- Low awareness and insufficient communication of jet ski speed limits

KEY FINDINGS

JET SKI PROVIDERS

MPA

- Moderate MPA awareness
- Moderate support for marine protection

Jet Skis

- Low awareness of jet ski impacts
- High awareness of speed limits
- Low openness to more regulations



MPA

- Moderate awareness of MPA existence
- Awareness mostly focused on cultural instead of natural value
- Strong support for marine protection

Jet Skis

- High safety risk perception
- Mixed awareness of the jet ski speed limit, but supportive
- Concerns about effectiveness of speed limit
